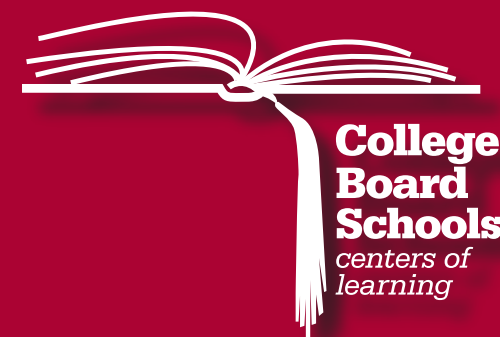

The Northeast College Preparatory School is a small school designed to promote academic excellence for all students. - Students and parents/guardians must agree to meet at least annually to design and update their individual road map
- Students must agree to adhere to the school's rules, procedures, and expectations
- Students must agree to adhere to the school's uniform policy
